Important things to know about the NEW ENERGY EFFICIENCY LOAN PROGRAM



The Energy Efficiency Loan Program (EELP), brought to you by the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador and takeCHARGE, is making it easier to save energy and money. On-bill financing with an interest rate of 4.7%* is available on insulation, heat pumps and home energy assessments. Through EELP, eligible applicants can receive low-interest financing for up to \$10,000 over a maximum of five years.

Minimum eligibility requirements for Heat Pumps, Insulation and Home Energy Assessment EELP Financing**:

- You must be the registered homeowner.
- Electricity must be your home's primary heating source.
- You must have at least 12 months history as the primary account holder with Newfoundland Power or Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro.
- Your home has been connected to the electricity system for at least 12 months.
- Credit check may be required.

And don't forget, your heat pump must be installed by both a:

- Journeyman Refrigeration And Air Conditioning Mechanic.
- Registered Electrical Contractor (Electrician) working under permit – Service NL maintains a listing of electrical contractors that are eligible to obtain a permit to do electrical work in Newfoundland and Labrador. Visit Service NL for a list of active electrical contractors in the province.

IF FINANCING INSULATION:

Your project must also meet the following minimum R-value requirements after the insulation is installed:

INSULATION LOCATION	R-VALUE REQUIREMENTS
Basement and Crawl Space Walls	18
Basement and Crawl Space Ceiling	30
Attic	50

IF FINANCING A HEAT PUMP:

Your home must also have one of the following minimum insulation levels at the time of application:

INSULATION LOCATION	R-VALUE REQUIREMENTS
Basement and Crawl Space Walls	12
Basement and Crawl Space Ceiling	20
Attic	32

If the property does not meet one of the minimums at the time of application, you must install attic or basement to the following levels. EELP low-interest financing and rebates are also available for this project.

INSULATION LOCATION	R-VALUE REQUIREMENTS
Basement and Crawl Space Walls	18
Basement and Crawl Space Ceiling	30
Attic	50

The unit must meet the following minimums:

TYPE OF HEAT PUMP	HSPF
Mini-Split	10 or higher
Multi-Split	9 or higher
Central Heat Pump	8.5 or higher
