

## WHY IT'S GREAT TO INSULATE!

- Having enough insulation will save you energy and money.



- Insulation keeps your house cozy when temperatures drop.



- Attic insulation helps keep your home cool in the summer and basement insulation combats humidity issues.



## IS YOUR HOME ELECTRICALLY HEATED?

Heating usually accounts for over 50% of the electricity used in electrically heated homes. Having enough insulation can save you hundreds in heating costs every year.

Get a rebate when you add insulation to your:

- 1 Attic 2 Basement ceiling or 3 Basement walls



## HOW TO APPLY?

**Apply by mailing to the utility that issues your electricity bill or online at [TakeChargeNL.ca](http://TakeChargeNL.ca).**

A copy of your purchase receipts must be included with the completed application. If your home is heated by oil, you must also include a current statement or receipt that shows a minimum of 1,000 litres of annual oil consumption.

Allow up to 8 weeks for processing, then look for the rebate applied as a credit on your electricity bill. Newfoundland Power and Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro may visit your home and confirm the insulation installation at any time within 15 months from when the rebate was processed.

## INVEST IN INSULATION

Insulation can save you thousands on heating costs. It's one of the wisest investments you can make in your home. And takeCHARGE is making it even easier to insulate with up to \$2,000 in rebates.

**75%** of the cost for insulation for your basement ceiling or walls up to \$1,000.

**50%** of the cost for insulation for your attic up to \$1,000.

## STEP 1 - IS YOUR HOME ELIGIBLE? ELECTRICALLY HEATED HOMES

- Your primary source of heat is electric. If an additional heating source is used, your home must have a minimum annual electricity usage of 15,000 kilowatt hours (kWh).
- You are the homeowner and the home has an active electricity account.
- Your home is on a permanent foundation and is intended as a primary residence.
- Your home was built and connected to the electricity system before January 1, 2014.
- If you have received a rebate for insulation from another rebate program, your takeCHARGE rebate may be prorated to ensure you do not receive a total rebate greater than 100% of your pre-tax material purchase.

## OIL HEATED HOMES - LIMITED AVAILABILITY

- Your home uses at least 1,000 liters of oil annually. A copy of a current annual statement that shows a minimum of 1,000 liters of oil consumption must be included with the application.
- Insulation was purchased on or after March 8, 2019.
- You are the homeowner and the home has an active electricity account.
- Your home is on a permanent foundation and is intended as a primary residence.
- Your home was built and connected to the electricity system before January 1, 2014.
- If you received funding for insulation through the Home Energy Savings Program you are not eligible for this rebate.

## STEP 2 - DOES YOUR INSULATION PROJECT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS?

**The R-Value MUST meet the following** minimum and maximum R-Value requirements after the insulation is installed:

INSULATION LOCATION	R-VALUE REQUIREMENTS	
	MIN	MAX
Basement and Crawl Space Walls*	R-18	R-25
Basement and Crawl Space Ceiling*	R-30	R-35
Attic	R-50	R-55 (R-60 in Labrador)

\*Rebates will be paid for basement/crawl space walls or basement/crawl space ceiling upgrades, but not both.

- You may add to existing insulation to reach the recommended R-value, but rebates will not be provided to replace existing insulation.
- Rebates are only available for the amount of insulation required to complete your project.
- The rebate applies to pre-tax insulation costs. Other materials and labour will not be reimbursed.
